### Sunday Serving Rosters

*Please tick the tasks that you'd like to help with.*

**Ushering**

Arrive at 6pm to prepare the Bulletins & handouts; welcome people at the door; help move people into the centre of the rows; tidy up the Lecture Theatre. 6 people per week.

**Supper**

Arrive at 6:15pm to set up the kitchen; serve supper after the service; clean up the kitchen. If able, bring some food for supper. 3 people per week.

**Supper - food only**

Provide home-prepared food without serving supper after the service.

### **Door Monitor**

Sit in the foyer throughout the 10am Service so that the King Street door can be left open. In general, we prefer men for this role. 1 person per week.

### **Info Table**

Sit at the Info Table during supper; receive payments for books and conferences; pack up the tables after supper. 2 people per week.

### **Money Counting**

Count the offertory money with a Warden after the service. 2 people per week, for 3-4 weeks in a row.

### **Communion Preparation**

Prepare plates of bread pieces and trays of grape juice for Communion. 2-3 people, once per month.

## **Other Rosters**

(Acceptance into these roles are dependant upon the pastor's approval.)*

### **Welcome Team**

With a team of others, keep a particular focus on welcoming newcomers to the service. Come early to the service to meet newcomers, try to sit with new people during the service, and invite them to supper. Stand at the Welcome Lounge in the foyer after the service to talk to newcomers. 4 people per week.

### **Presentations**

Arrive at 5pm to run through the song lyrics with the band; run the visual presentation throughout the service. (Training provided.) 1 person per week.

### **Bible Reading**

Prepare a Bible reading during the week; read the Bible in the service. 2 people per week.

### **Service Coordinator's Assistant**

Assist the service coordinator in managing volunteers, overseeing setup & packup, and other essential tasks for the service. 1 person per week.

### **Warden's Assistant**

Transport a car load of gear back to the Barneys Office after supper. Car essential. 1 person per week.
